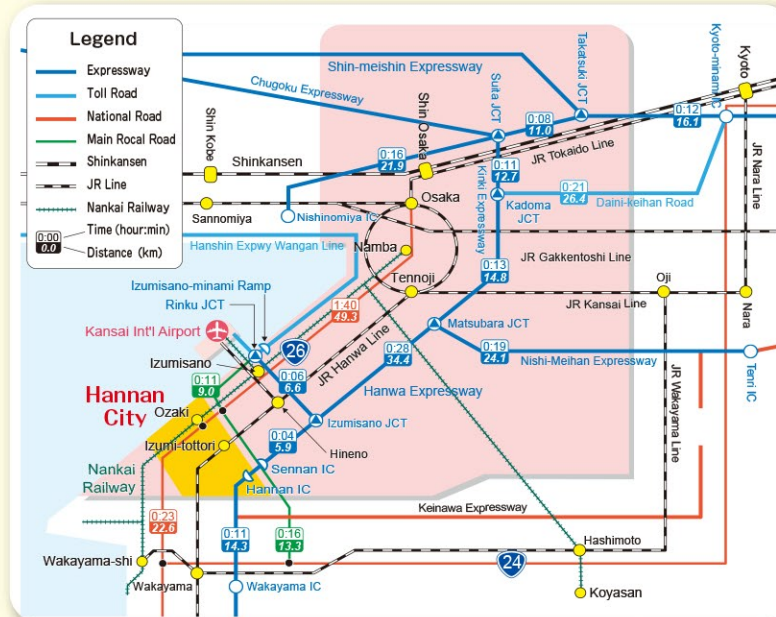

Just outside the station is a sea of pink



**Yamanakadani**

The atmospheric Kishū Kaidō highway is lined with cherry blossoms in spring. They are illuminated at night, enveloping visitors in a magical scene! The weeping cherry trees at Jifuku-ji are especially worth seeing. Don't miss the hydrangea flowers and fireflies in early summer too. Sakura Jizo is the presumed site of the Japanese heritage "Katsuragi Shugen" No. 4 Sutra mound. There is a theory that the stone monument next to the Yamanaka sekisho ruins monument is presumed ground, too.

## Spend some family time at Wampaku Ōkoku

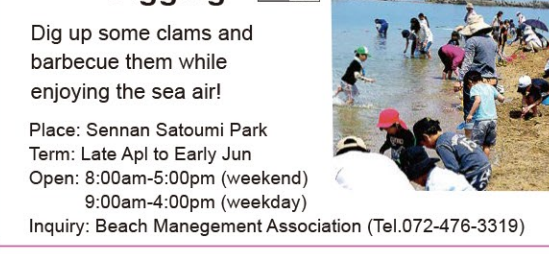
This fun park has playground equipment and a Wampaku fortress at the top of the mountain with superb views, grassy fields, a barbecue corner, and a giant roller slide.

## Hakotsukuri Beach

(Pichipichi Beach)

## Sennan Satsumi Park

This 2km long, narrow prefecture-run park spans between Hannan City and Misaki. Satsumi is a term that refers to the symbiotic relationship between people and the sea. Walk through the natural grounds, or play beach sports in the sea breeze. Regular events are held here year-round.

## Barbecue

**Yagura Festival**

A sense of accomplishment and satisfaction is in the air from both the people who pull the "yagura" and the many people who come to watch on this special autumn day. Don't miss the ascent to Hata Shrine, where the yagura are run up the stone stairs in one stretch. For a true spectacle, see each of the city's yagura that come together around city hall on the Sunday before the festival.

## Portable Shrine Imperial Procession

On the final day of the Autumn festival (national holiday Health and Sports Day), the portable shrines are carried from Hata Shrine to Ebino Beach in Ozaki.

## Shrines that house yagura

**Hata Shrine**

Listed in history books for its refined architectural style, 18 yagura are housed here.

**Sugawara Shrine**

The yagura from Hakotsukuri Higashi are housed at this shrine that honors Sugawara no Michizane and Susanoo-no-Mikoto.

**Kamo Shrine**

Related to the Kamigamo Shrines in Kyoto, the name of the Hakotsukuri area also gets its name from this shrine.

**Sashidemori Shrine**

Yagura from Kaikaku are housed here, a shrine famous for being the place where Empress Jitō visited with her son Emperor Ōjin.

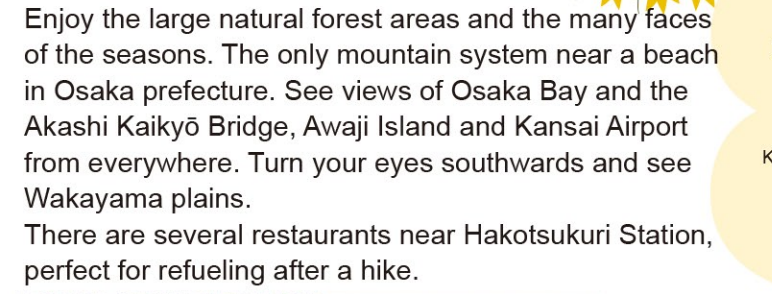
**Ginnomine and Kisen Alps Hiking Course**

**Nishihonganji Ozaki Branch**

Buildings surrounded by tall white walls. Ozaki Shrine next door is also worth a visit.

**Ozaki Port**

Narrow old alleys lead from Ozaki Station to the seaside, where you'll find an idyllic fishing port.

**Seaside Promenade**

Stroll in the sun while waves gently lap the shore. It's also a lovely spot to watch the sunset.

**Onosato River Tideland**

Flowering plants grow abundantly near the ocean's edge, seabirds gather, and a gentle sea breeze stirs the air.

Made of just azuki beans, rice flour, and sugar. No colorings, additives, or preservatives are used. The azuki beans are carefully washed to remove bitterness for this handmade delicacy.

**Daiganji Stone Statue**

At a height of 1.9m, this Izumi Sandstone Buddha statue is one of the largest in Osaka, and inscribed with the date 1546.

**Hata Shrine 36 J Poem Tablet**

36 framed pictures have the image of poet and their poems illustrated with brilliant colors. (Undiscovered)

**Hata Shrine Worship Stone**

Begin your shrine visit here. Two stones, and old and a new one stand here.

**Large Ginkgo Tree**

A noh theatre work, Inenaki, is said to be set here. It is designated the Natural monument of Osaka Prefecture.

## Special Product

The blessings of the sea can be found in fresh and processed seafood. In flatlands, mizu-nasu eggplant is synonymous with the Senshū region. Pickled mizu-nasu is famous nationwide. Also at the bottom of the Izumi mountain range, premium beef "Naniwa Kuroushi" is fattened without stress surrounded by clean water and clear air.

**Ikanago Kugini**

Local sand lance fish are used to make this additive-free handmade snack.

**Izumi Octopus**

Osaka Bay has plenty octopus food and it's very calm, resulting in soft, tasty octopus meat.

**Mizu-nasu(eggplant)**

This round eggplant is a specialty of Senshū. The skin is soft, and the flesh is so juicy that water can be squeezed out of it with your bare hands. Pickles made from these eggplants are famous nationwide.

**Naniwa-kuroushi (Beef)**

The valuable Kuroge Wagyu beef that only few cattle are shipped per month. It has a good balance of fine quality fat and lean, and characteristic of simply texture.
